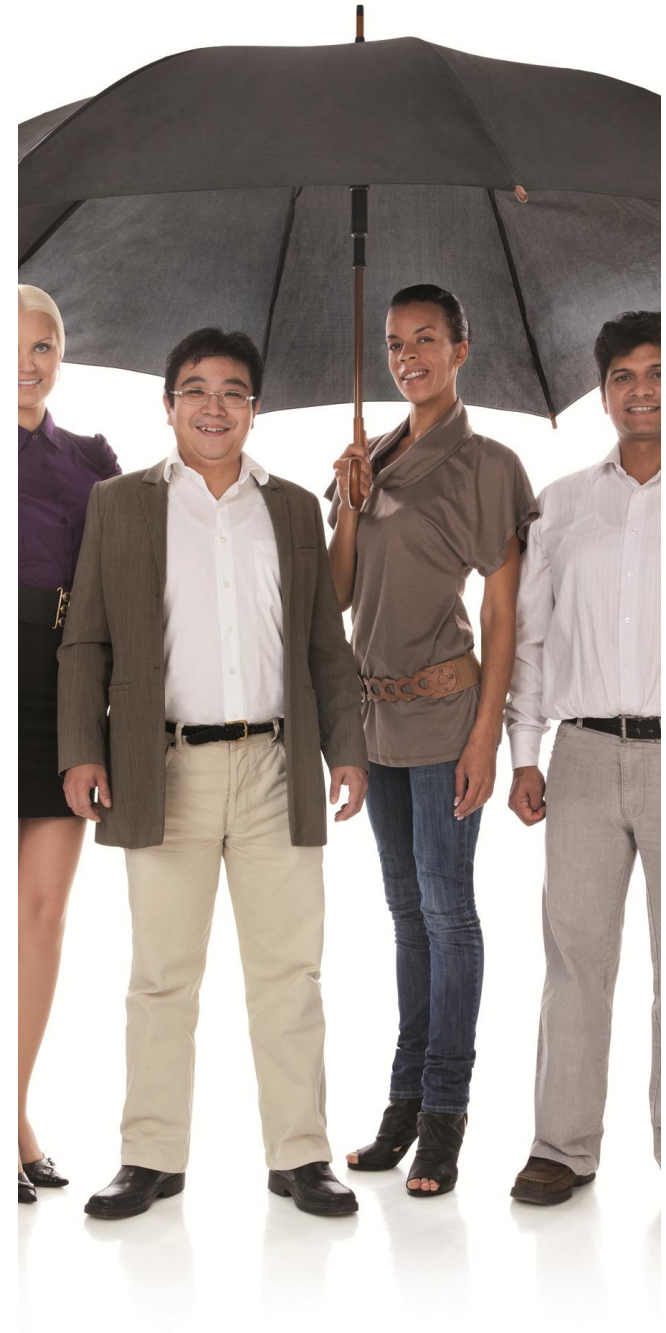

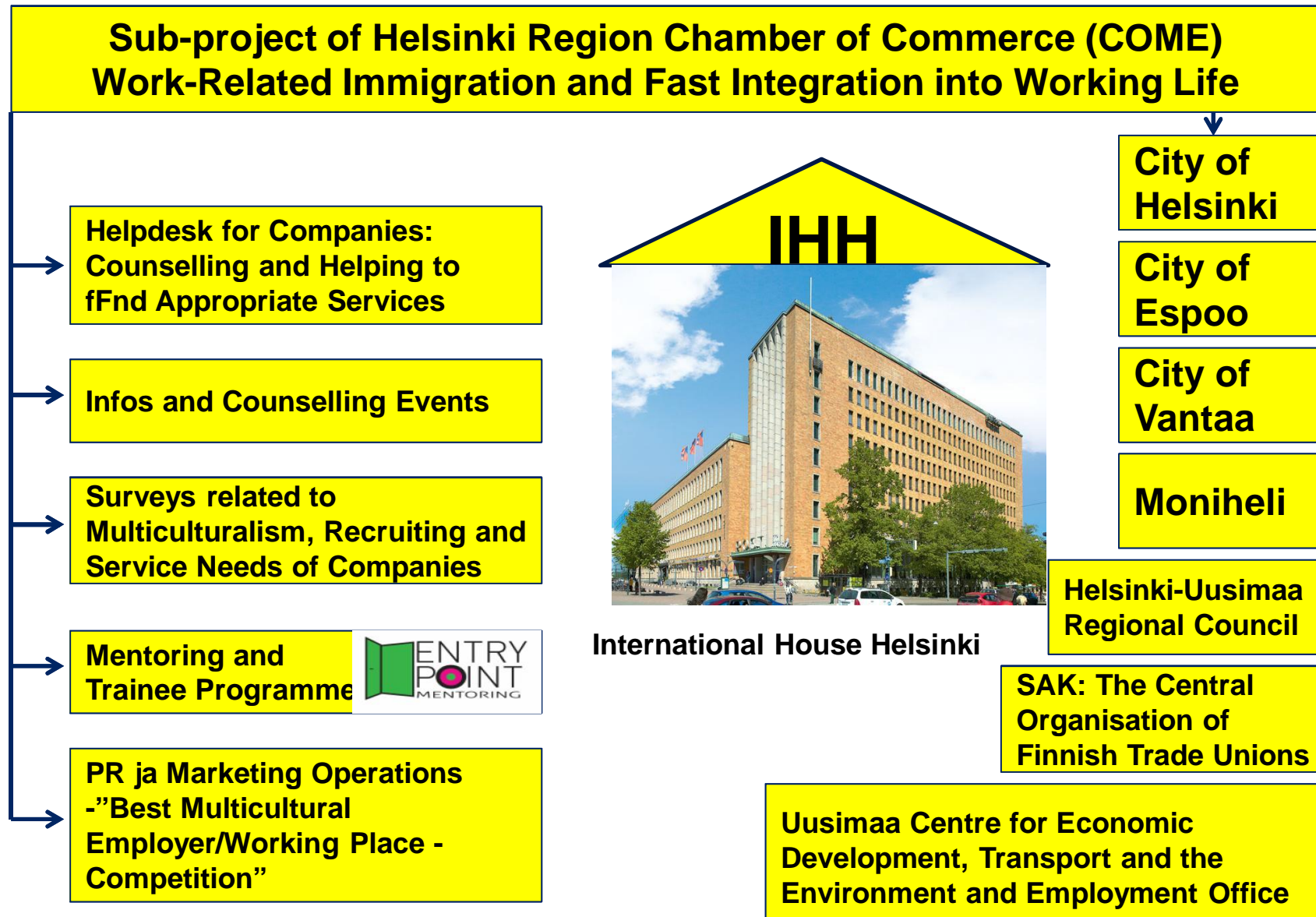

International students in Finland

42% had ever worked in Finland 78% felt comfortable in the Finnish culture

80% believed they will have a good chance to find job outside Finland

60% spoke more than 3 languages

85% are willing to work part-time

76% use Social Media for job seeking

75% didn't have a job

78% had never heard from me2we before

60% worked in their field

71% think university recruitment exhibitions are not useful

70% would like to stay in Finland

59% residence permit was expiring

79% who worked in Finland earned less than 1500€/month

71% were looking jobs out of their field

88% think it's difficult to find a job in Finland
